

FY 2025 Continuum of Care Competition and Youth Homeless Demonstration Program Grants Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO)

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) released the Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2025 Continuum of Care (CoC) Program Competition and Youth Homeless Demonstration Program Grants on November 13, 2025 EST with approximately \$3.918 billion in funding available.

Funding includes approximately \$52 million for Domestic Violence, Dating Violence, Sexual Assault, and Stalking Bonus (DV Bonus) projects. Roughly \$129 million is made available for the renewal of projects originally awarded as part of the Unsheltered and Rural Homelessness Supplement NOFO. Additionally, about \$228 million is available for the competitive renewal and replacement of expiring YHDP grants. Jurisdictional funding for Guam will be available soon after this announcement.

The deadline to submit CoC Consolidated Applications and project applications for FY 2025 funds is 8:00 PM EDT on January 14, 2026 via e-snaps at <https://esnaps.hud.gov/>.
